GUIDELINES FOR CARPET PROTECTION FILM

Please read before using this product

USAGE

- 1. Protects against spills, scratches, stains & dirt during building works, remodeling, painting, decoration and furniture removal.
- 2. Heavy duty rip-resistant material
- 3. Self-adhesive makes it quick and easy to apply and remove
- 4. This protection film is to be used as temporary surface protection against dust, paint, plaster and potential scratching. This is not designed for protection against corrosion, humidity or chemicals.

APPLICATION

- 1. Before applying the film ensure the surface is clean and dry.
- 2. <u>It is recommended to test the product on small area of the surface prior to using</u>. Test the film for 48 hours on a small hidden area of carpet to ensure compatibility with the carpet and to ensure that there is no adhesive transfer or damage to carpet.
- 3. Do not store or use above 37°C or below 4°C. The product should be stored at room temperature 24 hours prior to application.
- 4. To apply the roll, lay it on the floor facing the direction required to cover. Push the roll forward a small distance and press down firmly to ensure the film has adhered to the carpet.
- 5. Continue to unroll, pressing down and smoothing out any air pockets, checking the film is rolled straight.

LIMITATIONS

- 1. Do not leave the film on carpet for longer than 30 days.
- 2. The film can be stored for up to six months in its original packaging at room temperature and in dry conditions.
- 3. For use on synthetic carpets only.
- 4. Film is single use only. Remove and dispose of in accordance with local environmental regulations.
- 5. Do not use on wool or oriental carpets. Not suitable for use on rugs, worn carpets or loose fitted carpet tiles.
- 6. Do not use on hard surfaces, such as hardwood, ceramic tiles, linoleum, vinyl flooring or marble.
- 7. **Do not apply on newly laid carpets** where a glue or adhesive has been used. Allow up to 72 hours for any vapours to evaporate before laying the film.
- 8. <u>Do not apply to a damp surface</u>, as this will prevent any moisture from evaporating and could cause discoloration of carpet fibers.
- 9. If the carpet had been recently cleaned, allow it to completely dry for a minimum of 10 days before using the film.
- 10. Usually high traffic areas or outdoor exposure may require renewal of film weekly.
- 11. The product should be applied at room temperature.
- 12. No responsibility will be taken for the misuse of this product, or the consequences of such non-recommended applications. Use of the product for non-recommended applications is done so at users own risk. Our liability is limited to the cost of or replacement of a defective product and does not cover any claims for consequential losses. It is recommended that the whole room floor is covered to avoid dirt distribution.
- 13. Avoid prolonged periods in direct sunlight.
- 14. It is recommended that the whole room carpet is covered to avoid dirt distribution.
